# Nonprofit Capacity Building Grant Program

#### WHAT?

- Responsive Grant Program
- Capacity Building Defined
  - Investing in an organization's ability to grow, **sustain** impact, and **adapt** whether through refinement, expansion, collaboration, or even sunsetting in service of its mission and the greater good.





## Nonprofit Capacity Building Grant Program



### WHAT? (cont'd)


- Four Funding Avenues
  - Experiences up to \$10,000
  - ➤ Planning up to \$25,000
  - ➤Implementation up to \$100,000
  - ➤ System-Wide Infrastructure up to \$250,000



# Nonprofit Capacity Building Grant Program

### WHAT? (cont'd)

- > Have one active application under review.
- > AND, you CAN apply more than once!
- > Complete a brief close-out report when reapplying.







# Eligibility



#### WHO?

### Eligible

- >501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations that:
  - Have been in existence for at least five years
  - Have a current submitted IRS Form 990
  - Are **LOCATED** in the St. Croix Valley Foundation service area including Chisago and Washington counties in Minnesota and Burnett, Polk, St. Croix and Pierce counties in Wisconsin.



# Eligibility

### WHO? (cont'd)

- Ineligible:
  - ➤ Private foundations, government entities, sectarian religious programs/organizations, and fiscal sponsorships
  - > Organizations headquartered outside our service area currently delivering programming in or looking to expand into SCVF's six-county service area.
  - Capital projects / General Operating Expenses







# Eligibility



### WHO? (cont'd)

- Capacity-building work varies greatly!
- Organizations of <u>ALL</u> sizes encouraged to apply.




## Timeline

#### WHEN?

- Applications Open: October 13, 2025
- **Deadline:** Rolling!
- Review Schedule: Reviewed quarterly. To be considered in a review cycle, applications must be received by:
  - November 30 (notifications sent in December)
  - February 28 (notifications sent in March)
  - May 31 (notifications sent in June)
  - August 31 (notifications sent in September)
- **Grants:** Awards processed shortly after notifications.


