

2021 Fall Grants Program Guidelines

Grants considered by **Northwest Alliance Community Foundation** (NACF) are generally awarded to organizations that meet the following guidelines:

- 1. The project or services proposed must be in our area (north of Highway 8 in Polk Cty, all of Burnett Cty)
- 2. Grantees need to be a 501(c)(3) nonprofit or tax-exempt organization. Requests should be related to the organization's mission.
- 3. No more than 1 grant will be awarded per group or organization per year.
- **4.** The grant request must be for future expenses, not costs already incurred by the group or organization, and must be used within 1 year of receiving the funds.
- 5. Proposals should include a clear statement of how the grant will have an impact on their project.
- **6.** Grantees will be required to submit a brief written report (1 page) summarizing the results of the project, including the number of individuals impacted, along with a final financial report detailing how the grant money was spent. Photos and a success story are appreciated.
- 7. Grantees agree to acknowledge NACF in all communication about the grant.

NACF generally does not cover: • General operating expenses • Salaries • General requests

NACF tends to award: • Specific requests • Special projects • Unique ideas

Total being granted this cycle: \$8,000 (usually among 3-4 organizations)

NACF Priority Area: • Educational Programs

All eligible applicants will be ranked on the following criteria: (Maximum points)

- Organization Description (10 Points)
- Community Need (20 Points)
- Goals, activities and outcomes (20 Points)
- Implementation and Management of Funds (20 Points)
- Use of funds (20 Points)
- Other (10 Points)

All applications must be submitted online by **Friday Oct 15, 2021**. Applicants will be notified on or before Dec. 30, 2021.
